

Dear Parents and carers,

Please see below a few reminders for next Monday 20th July and an update on the staffing at CPPS:

**Remote and flexible learning commences on Monday 20th July.
Students who can learn from home must do so.**

Remote Learning platform

1. Following the feedback from parents/carers last term, the school has moved away from DB Primary to a new platform – Seesaw. Teachers have been busy preparing videos, lesson plans and activities suited to your child ability.
2. From Monday 9:00am Seesaw will begin with all students online. For their academic benefit and social engagement with peers and the school it is important your child has access to a device to login and access this program.
3. We understand that not all students will be able to login first thing in the morning due to the home structure. In order for the attendance to be marked on time we encourage all families to develop a structure at home that enables the students time to connect with the school prior to 10:00am each day.
4. Laptops/iPads are available to loan from the school. Currently parents have been collecting these from the front office and we are taking a waiting list for further devices. We encourage all families to contact us if their child/ren need devices.
5. Book packs will be made available for those that do not have access to a device and have yet to collect one from the school. Students will still be required to complete the work each week and return it to the school office in order for more work to be sent home. Parents of these students will need to be available via phone during the day so teachers can contact them to discuss their child's progress.

On-site supervision

1. On-site school supervision is offered in certain circumstances, including where students have parents as essential workers, and no other arrangements for home learning can be made.
2. For on-site supervision, parents must complete the 'On-site attendance form', and send to the office by the Thursday prior to the following week.
3. All students on-site will have their temperature checked on arrival.
4. **The entry will be at the FRONT SCHOOL GATE, from 8.45am- 9.15am.**
5. Please be patient as we need to mark students present and conduct the checks.
6. If students are unwell they must not attend.
7. If your child is collected throughout the day, they should not return back to school.

We will continue to update parents/carers with information. We thank the school community for your support this week and moving forward. If you have any concerns or questions please email the school and we will make contact with you.
