Dear families,

COVID POSITIVE CASE

Earlier tonight I was notified by the Department of Health and the Department of Education that a confirmed COVID-19 case has been in contact with staff and students from our school.

The school is **not** required to close. Cleaning and contact of those impacted has already been completed earlier tonight. I want to assure you that the correct process has been followed and all families have been notified.

If you have not been contacted to say your child needs a COVID test you do not need to do anything and your child/ren should return to school as normal tomorrow.

CLOSE CONTACTS

If you have been contacted or you are contacted later tonight it is important your child has a COVID test ASAP. In order to return to school, your child's negative test result needs to be produced to the school.

If your child is confirmed as a positive case please notify us immediately and begin the isolation process.
