Dear families,

Cranbourne Park Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of our parent payment arrangements for 2021. The school has been working extremely hard to consider what essential items are required for 2021 and re-design our curriculum for the best interests of your child/ren. Next year the school will be purchasing licences for students to engage with their learning online as per the remote and flexible learning this year. The skills developed during this process are essential to the ongoing learning of your child/ren and connect in with the curriculum.

Please find the fee schedule for all year levels attached. Please complete this form and return to the school with payment no later than **Friday 11th December 2020**. In 2021 we cannot guarantee the cost of the packs will be the same due to supply issues created from the COVID climate and the timeline for delivery. Those ordered and paid for before the end of the school year will guarantee delivery for the start of the 2021 school year. Packs will be delivered directly to the classroom once they have arrived.

Cranbourne Park Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents. We have continued to work with a range of suppliers to ensure we are getting the best value for money items that ensure all students have the same access to resources. Students will be sharing resources throughout the year and it is important that all students have the same quality, quantity and design. The supplier is unable to split book packs this year so we request all families to purchase the entire pack rather than try to purchase items separately.

Financial Support for Families

The School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and as such we offer a range of support options, including:

- the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund to assist with school excursions and incursions,
- State Schools Relief support to assist with student uniform,
- payment plans for school essential items,
- other arrangements made between the parent/carer and the Principal
