PARENT PAYMENTS 2022

The parent payments policy has been approved by the Department of Education and is now ready to go to all families. The school has secured the same pricing of materials as 2021 however they will be delivered to the school in bulk rather than individual packs. This will allow teachers to distribute materials a lot easier to students.

The cost per student is \$150. Forms will be emailed out to all families this week, card payments can be made via phone or cash payments at the school office. *Please note: if you come into the school building you must QR code sign in and a face mask must be worn. Under new operational guidelines if you are not wearing a mask, a letter providing a medical exemption must be provided.*

We look forward to continuing to deliver a new and engaging program for 2022, this is only made possible through parent payments. If parents need support for payments please speak with Chris in the office.

2022 STUDENT PLACEMENTS

Staffing is well underway for 2022 and we are soon starting to place students in grades.
