



COVID LOCKDOWN

Dear families,

As you may have just heard, the State Government has announced another 5 (five) day lockdown effective from **11.59pm tonight through to 11.59pm Tuesday night** for the whole state of Victoria.

The Premier has announced that there are limited number of workplaces that will remain open. The same settings that were in place for the previous lockdown are the same settings this time. As a result there will be limited number of students who can attend school. The school will remain open for the following students:

- Students whose parents are essential workers and documentation is provided
- Students who are deemed vulnerable and documentation is provided

If your child attended school during the previous lockdown they will be able to attend school for the current lockdown. Please note documentation needs to be provided to ensure students who can attend are able to attend. *For the ongoing safety of all it is important that students who can stay home or be supervised by someone away from school do stay home.*

The school will connect with students through remote learning from tomorrow morning with the anticipation that students will return to on-site learning from Wednesday morning.

Tomorrow is not a pupil free day. Students will need to continue with their learning at home. Given the short timeframe for teachers to plan online learning it is expected teachers will not connect with students until 10:00am.

From this time the teachers will be available to support students in their learning online. Further information will be available tomorrow once the Department of Education have provided us with further direction and advice, please be patient and respectful to the office staff if you call.
